



Phonics and Reading

Phonics is taught following the Letters and Sounds programme. The Letters and Sounds programme clearly follow the six phases of phonic progression throughout the Early Years and Key Stage 1. Phonics is taught explicitly and systematically each day in Early Years and Key Stage 1 and consolidated throughout in KS2.

We use a range of reading scheme books to meet the needs and interests of our pupils. Our letters and sounds resources come from the Collins Big Cat series. Our reading scheme runs from the Early Years to the end of Key Stage 2, whereby once children finish the scheme, they become independent readers who select their own books as they are at a point in their reading journey to be able to read fluently and accurately with excellent comprehension. At the same time children may take home other reading books for them to practice their reading skills with such as those from our school library or the class reader area.
