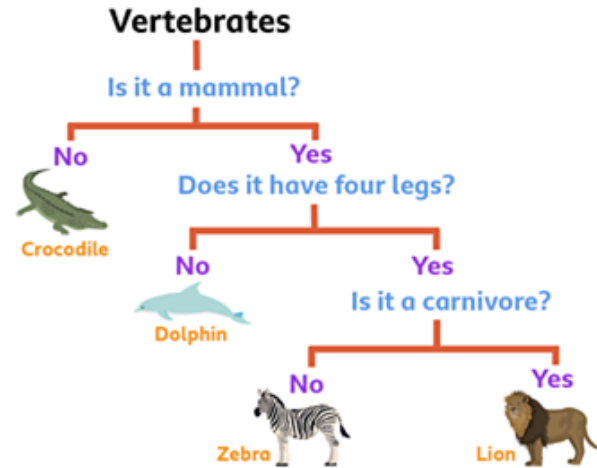


Important Facts:

- Classification keys use yes/no questions to find the answer
- Classification keys use observable features

Vocabulary:

classification	sorting things into groups based on what they have in common
classification key	a tool that helps us identify living things by asking yes/no questions
habitat	the natural home of a living thing
identify	to find out what something is
simple leaf	a leaf that is one whole shape
compound leaf	a leaf made up of smaller leaves
invertebrate	an animal without a backbone
vertebrate	an animal that has a backbone
