Key Vocabulary	Definition
Border	A line that separates two areas of land. For example England and Scotland.
Perspective	A persons ability to look at something from different view points.
Culture	A culture is a way of life shared by a society or group of people. Many different things make up a society's cultures such as food, language, clothing, music, arts, beliefs, celebrations and religion. Older people pass culture down to younger people
Continent	A continent is a large area of land made up of different countries. These countries are separated by borders.
