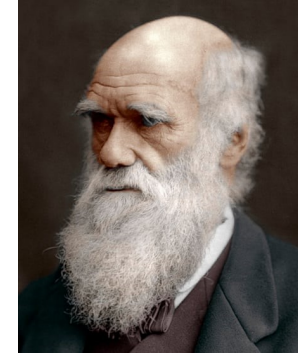

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Tundra	a vast, flat, treeless Arctic region of Europe, Asia, and North America in which the subsoil is permanently frozen.
Woodland	land covered with trees.
Grasslands	a large open area of country covered with grass, especially one used for grazing.
Savannah	a grassy plain in tropical and subtropical regions, with few trees.
Biome	Biomes are areas of our planet with similar climates, landscapes, animals and plants.
