What have Reception been learning about this week?

We have had a lovely couple of weeks in reception getting to know our new classrooms, teachers and routines. Our topic for this term is All About Me and we started off this week by talking about our families. We have shared family photos and talked about who is in our family and if they look similar or different to us. In maths we have been looking at numbers 1,2 and 3 and showing how we can represent them in different ways such as with counters, with numicon and by writing the numbers.







What have Year 2 been learning about this week?


Wow Year 2! You have really shown such dedication and enthusiasm in this week's learning. In Maths, we have continued our topic of place value and have learned how to compare objects and numbers. Our English unit continued with our story of The Tunnel, where we changed certain features and wrote a narrative. There were some really spooky descriptions of haunted houses involved which definitely scared some of the Year 2 teachers! Our Reading unit continued as we read Claude Going for Gold and with such a big focus on vocabulary, we are certainly learning lots of new words. In Science we have learned about our living things and their habitats. Did you know that even our playground can be considered a habitat? We hope that everyone had a lovely week and as we learned in our RE lessons, remember to be kind!











What have Year 4 been learning about this week?

Wow, what an exciting week we've had in Year 4! We have been very busy with our wonderful learning. In our reading lesson, we have started reading Why The Whales Came by Michael Morpurgo and we have enjoyed exploring the new vocabulary. In English, we have been busy writing all about a real-life setting- this week it has been a train station. We have enjoyed writing collaboratively (please see the photo below) and next week we will apply our learning as we write an independent piece.


In maths, we have started learning about 4 digit numbers- something which is new in Year 4. We have been using practical resources to support our learning and have been testing our fluency and problem solving skills. In science, we have been learning all about sound – what it is, how it's made and how it travels. We have also been exploring the pitch of sounds by using musical instruments.



What have Year 6 been learning about this week?

Wow! What a fantastic start to Year 6 we have had already. We have been reading Letters From the Lighthouse - by Emma Carroll - as our class text and have been revisiting the skill of vocabulary. As with all children in the school, we have been looking at 'Place Value' in maths but we have moved on to looking at millions numbers and this week we have been rounding decimal numbers. In English, we have been working on improving our use of descriptive devices when imitating an escape story. We cannot wait to write our own next week. If that wasn't enough, we have been exploring North America in Geography, revising towns and activities in French and have been planning and carrying out our first investigation in Science. Ask us what we have learned about light and shadows from our investigation this week.

I am really looking forward to seeing the progress you all make this term with your times tables... I wonder who will be a Rock Hero by the end of the year? – Miss Gundry


