Celebrating Positive Feedback

This week, we also welcomed the Strategic Lead of School Effectiveness from the Local Authority. Following her visit, she shared some wonderful feedback about the school, and I wanted to share her observations with you:

- "I was struck by the calm and purposeful working environment the school provides, the high expectations and caring relationships on display. We saw some strong instruction, and, in every classroom, children were focused on their work and collaborating well together. The children I spoke to about their work had good recall of prior lessons in the sequence and had retained key knowledge and vocabulary.
- Behaviour was well-ordered across the school, including in lessons with cover teachers. Children from nursery to year six, and those with special needs, clearly understood and enacted key routines and expectations. Staff made clear their expectations using verbal reminders and instructions."

We are incredibly proud of our staff and students for creating such a positive and enriching learning environment.



Parking

A friendly reminder to please refrain from parking on double yellow lines or zig zag markings. Doing so poses a danger to our children as they enter and leave the school premises. Additionally, we kindly ask that disabled badge holders avoid parking in these restricted areas. If you hold a disabled badge and require proximity to the school for accessibility reasons, please reach out to our office. We're here to support you in finding suitable parking arrangements.

Uniform

Could we please ask Parents/Carers to make sure all uniforms are clearly <u>labelled</u>. Nearly all the uniform emptied from the lost property bins is unnamed, making it impossible to return to the rightful owners.

School lunches

Parents are now able to cancel and book school dinners up to 9am in the morning. Please remember to order for your child before this time and cancel any meals not required should your child be absent for the day, you will still be charged if meals aren't cancelled. Meals should only be ordered by the school office on the <u>rare occasion</u> that you may have forgotten to order. We are still experiencing a high number of pupils every day that have no school dinner ordered – if this continues, we will phone parents to bring in a packed lunch so could you ensure you have booked for the week ahead. Please speak to the school office if you need a reminder of how to order through Parent Pay.
