COVID-19

With the increase in infection rates, the government have <u>tightened guidance on measures</u>, testing and isolation.

Staffing: as with all sectors and education providers, we are expecting a real stretch on staffing capacity this term (this is already being tested with 15% of the staff off). I would ask for your patience and understanding as staff absence will always impact on the learning and progress of pupils. We have no intention of closing classes or year groups unless it is the absolute last resort

Attendance: please follow the flow chart for further information and guidance. Your child must attend school if they are well enough and not showing symptoms.

Remote education: if your child is isolating and not unwell, the school will email remote education packs, a letter with links and details and information. Your child must continue their learning at home (for Rec-Year 2 this should be for 3 hours a day and for Y3-6 for 4 hours a day). All pupils must read every day at home. Miss Fernandez will send out further guidance and support for reading later this month. We will also be opening up opportunities for parents/carers to volunteer to read with children in school again once the current COVID-19 wave dies down.

Parent and Carer Volunteers

As I shared in the newsletter before Christmas, we intend to build up our parent volunteers in school once again. We will however wait for the current COVID-19 rates to decrease and for a change in guidance from the Department of Education before we do. It is intended that we will focus on three strands initially:

- 1. Turning the allotments into a Palmer Families Community Garden.
- 2. Reading with individuals in school.
- 3. Fundraising activities.

In due course, I will ask for volunteers for each strand. Please note that all adults coming into school and working with children will be required to go through stringent safer recruitment checks in line with Keeping Children Safe in Education. This will involve gathering references for your suitability to work with children and an Enhanced Disclose and Barring Service check ('police check').

We very much look forward to having our parents part and parcel of what we do and supporting all the children.
