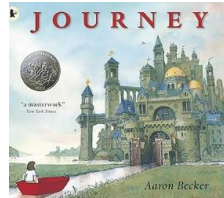




Sycamore Newsletter

In **English** lessons this term, we will be looking at the book Journey by Aaron Becker. Children will focus on writing detailed description of the setting and using their imagination in story telling.



In **Maths** we will learning about Money and Shape. Furthermore, we will also be working on quick recall of times tables. Year 4s will take a times table test this half term. Regular practise of new tables and repetition of ones previously learnt is invaluable. Here is a link to support you doing this at home:

Reading – Your child will bring home a book at their level. Reading with an adult remains really important so new words and understanding can be discussed. We ask that you aim to read daily with your child, making a note in their student journal.

Homework

In addition to reading and timetables, you child will receive a Homework Grid. There are a variety of tasks from which they need to pick 3 to complete by the end of the half term. Home work books can be handed in on a Friday to be marked.

Student Planners

Your child will have a student planner. There is space for reading to be logged and messages written by home and school. These will be checked daily in school and we ask that you do the same at home to aid communication. There is space for you to sign at the end of the week to show you have accessed this.

Geography



In Geography, we will be learning about Europe. We will look at what countries are located in Europe, capital cities and human and physical features.

DT and Art

In DT children will be looking at electrical systems and in Art children will be looking at working in three dimensions, the art of display.



Science

Children will be learning about Forces and Magnets. We will look at poles and how magnets attract and repel.

PHSE

In PSHE we will look at 'Rights and Respect.'
