

COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL

In **<u>English</u>** lessons this term, we are looking at the book Orion and the Dark. By Emma Yarlett. Our final piece will be a diary entry.



<u>In Maths</u> we will be learning about decimals and then moving onto the topic of shape. We will also continue working on quick recall of times tables. Year 4s will take a times table test this term. Regular practise of new tables and repetition of ones previously learnt is invaluable. Details of tables to be practised are on your child's homework grid. Here are some links to support you doing this at home:

Reading – Your child will have 2 reading books. One is an AR book chosen according to their reading range. Reading with an adult remains really important so new words and understanding can be discussed. We ask that you aim to read daily with your child, making a note in their student journal. House points are awarded for every time they have read at home (with written proof !) Your child will also be read at least once a week in school.

Their second book is chosen from our class library and is to be enjoyed as you wish, looking at the pictures, a book for you to read to your child or to read together.

<u>Homework</u>

In addition to reading and timetables, you child has received a Homework Grid. There are a variety of tasks from which they need to pick 3 to complete by the end of term.

Student Planners

Your child will have a student planner. There is space for reading to be logged and messages written by home and school. These will be checked daily in school and we ask that you do the same at home to aid communication. There is space for you to sign at the end of the week to show you have accessed this. Geography

We will be learning about Bradford. We will be looking at the key questions of 'What makes Bradford a city?' and 'How has Bradford changed over time?' We will be visiting Bradford and Saltaire on a trip this half term.

<u>DT</u>

We will be making tartlets this half term, focusing on locality and seasonality. Children will design, plan and make their tartlets in lessons.

We will be learning about habitats this half term with a focus on wildflowers. We will also look at how the environment can affect this.

We will be looking spending, saving and budgeting.
