

Autumn Term 2026

History

Our focus is The Stone Age. The children will be learning about the timeline of events that took place during the Bronze Age, Stone Age and Iron Age.

RE

The topic for this term is 'What do Muslims celebrate' diving into the different celebrations.

Design Technology

The children will be looking at structures aiming to design a stable pavilion structure that is aesthetically pleasing.

MFL

Our Spanish focus is 'Where do you live?' and shapes and colours.

Computing

We will be learning about online safety and computing systems.

Music

The children have an instrumental topic with a South African focus.

Science

Our topic in the first half term will be 'Rocks'. We will compare different types of rocks, look at how rocks are formed and identify what soils and fossils are. The second half term focus is 'Electricity'. The children will name different element and construct simple circuits while conducting experiments using switches.

Maths

Our curriculum focus this term will be number, place value, addition and subtraction. We will also be developing the children's times tables and mental arithmetic skills.

PSHE

The children will be focussing on the topics 'Identity and Well being' and 'Resilience and self esteem'

PE

PE will cover a range of topics this term including, football, dance, gymnastics and problem solving.

Art

The art topic for this term is painting and Mixed Media with the children painting with control to make a still life with recognisable objects.
