

Maths

Our curriculum focus this term will be multiplication, division, fractions, percentages, decimals, length and perimeter. We will be developing the children's times tables and mental arithmetic skills daily as well as testing weekly.

History

Our focus is Ancient Egypt. The children will be learning about the timeline of events that took place during this time as well as exploring the lives of key individuals.

RE

The topic for this term is 'What is the bible and why is it important to Christians?'

Design Technology

Our topic for this term will allow the children to design, build and test their very own sling shot car.

MFL

Our Spanish focus is 'At the Spanish market' and 'Weather in Spain'

Computing

We will be learning about network and the journey inside a computer.

Music

The children have an instrumental topic with a Caribbean focus.

Science

Our topic in the first half term will be 'Forces and Magnets'. The children will be learning the push and pull forces as well as conducting experiments using magnets and metals.
