

# KS1 Summer Term 2025

## Maths

Y1: In maths, we will be learning all about the place value of numbers to 100 and beginning to explore **multiplication** and **division**. We will also look at money and begin to read a clock face showing **o'clock** and **half past** times.

Y2: We will learn all about recording data using **pictograms**, **block graphs**, and **tally charts**. Also, we will learn how to read a clock face showing **quarter past** and **quarter to** times. We will also continue to practice our 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

## R.E

In R.E we will focus on **Christianity** and **Hinduism** this term. We will learn all about Christian Rites of Passage, and Hindu celebrations.

## Jigsaw/PHSE

In jigsaw our themes this term are Changing Me and Relationships.

## English

This term we will be focusing on the text 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson. We will produce different types of texts such as a retelling of the story, a debate and a setting description. We will continue to learn how to write sentences and paragraphs with growing accuracy and complexity. Year 1 will also continue our Monster Phonics to prepare for the phonics screen.



## P.E

We will be focusing on ball games involving rackets and will develop our **hand/eye coordination** to be able to strike a moving ball with a tennis racket. We will also develop our running skills and discuss the impact of P.E on our health and wellbeing.

## Geography

Our geography topic this term is 'Our School Grounds.' We will collect **data** regarding the **plant life in** our school garden. We will also learn the four **compass** directions: North, South, East and West.

## Art

In art we will be inspired by the artist **Romare Bearden**. We will continue to explore **primary** and **secondary** colours and **collage**.

## DT

We will be designing, making and evaluating a moving toy using **levers, linkages and pivots**.

## History

In history we will be learning about **Victorian** times. We will use different **sources** to **compare** seaside holidays in **Victorian** times to seaside holidays today.

## Science

Our topic in science this term is **animals including humans**. We will explore what all living things need to survive including **food, water and air**. We will also discuss the impact of **exercise** on the human body and why it is so important. Additionally, we will learn to match animals to the names of their **offspring**.

## Computing

In computing this term, we will explore stop-motion animation. First we will create our own flipbooks. Then we will have a go at planning and creating our own space stop motion animations using stop motion studio.

## Music

In music we will be using our voices and instruments to create an under the sea soundscape. We will explore how the volume (**dynamics**) and **tempo** changes the mood.
