KS1 Summer Term 2025

Maths

Y1: In maths, we will be learning all about the place value of numbers to 100 and beginning to explore multiplication and division. We will also look at money and begin to read a clock face showing o'clock and half past times.

Y2: We will learn all about recording data using pictograms, block graphs, and tally charts. Also, we will learn how to read a clock face showing quarter past and quarter to times. We will also continue to practice our 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

R.E

In R.E we will focus on **Christianity** and <u>Hinduism</u> this term. We will learn all about Christian Rites of Passage, and Hindu celebrations.

<u>Jigsaw/PHSE</u>

In jigsaw our themes this term are Changing Me and Relationships.

English

This term we will be focusing on the text 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson. We will produce different types of texts such as a retelling of the story, a debate and a setting description. We will continue to learn how to write sentences and paragraphs with growing accuracy and complexity. Year 1 will also continue our Monster Phonics to prepare for the phonics screen.



<u>Science</u>

Our topic in science this term is <u>animals including</u> humans. We will explore what all living things need to survive including food, water and air. We will also discuss the impact of **exercise** on the human body and why it is so important. Additionally, we will learn to match animals to the names of their offspring.

Computing

In computing this term, we will explore stop-motion animation. First we will create our own flipbooks. Then we will have a go at planning and creating our own space stop motion animations using stop motion

<u>Music</u>

In music we will be using our voices and instruments to create an under the sea soundscape. We will explore how the volume (dynamics) and tempo changes
