On **Friday 26th May**, our academy will be celebrating King Charles III's Coronation. Due to SATs being the week of the occasion, the academy will be holding different events on the last day of term to mark the special event. All the children will be involved in a variety of activities. Each Key Stage 2 class will create a piece of art which will be inspired by one of the King's landscapes that he has created himself. Early Years and Key Stage 1 classes will be making other wonderful creations which will be put on display in the academy. There will be a 'Royal-Themed' quiz where house teams will have the chance to collect house points. Classes will also have the opportunity to 'S.H.I.N.E' in our 'Thrunscoe's Got Talent' Show.

On the 26th May we are inviting all of our wonderful children within the academy to join us in a "street party" over lunchtime. Everyone is invited to bring their own special lunch in, as part of the celebrations. Please remember that lunches should be **nut-free**.
