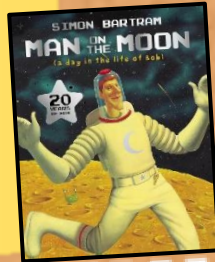
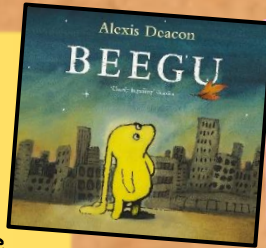


KS1 Autumn Term 2024-2025

English

This term we are going to be reading the texts, *Beegu* and *Man on the Moon*, and using these to inspire our writing. We will produce a range of different types of texts and learn how to write sentences remembering to include capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will also continue to learn our monster phonics sounds.



Jigsaw/PHSCE

Our jigsaw topics this term are being me in my world and celebrating difference.

Key vocabulary: Safe, Happy, Worried, Nervous, Rights, Responsibilities, Rewards

Music

We will explore timbre and create a rhythmic pattern to tell a familiar fairy-tale.

RE

In RE, will learn about the Hindu festival Diwali and compare it with the Christian festival, Christmas.

PE

In P.E will we explore games involving ball skills, teambuilding and will later move onto dance.

Mathematics

Y1: We will be learning the place value of numbers to 20 and exploring how many tens and ones they contain. Next we will learn how to add and subtract numbers within 10. We will also learn to recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes.

Y2: We will be learning the place value of numbers to 100 and exploring how many tens and ones they contain. Next we will add and subtract numbers beginning with one -digit and progressing to using two, two-digit numbers. We will also be learning the 10, 2 and 5 times tables.

Science

Our science topic this term is animals including humans. We will learn about a variety of different animals and identify if they are fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds or mammals. We will also learn all about our five senses. Key vocabulary: Animal, Mammal, Bird, Fish.

Art

In art we will create maps through various art forms including drawing, felt-making, and printmaking We will explore artwork created by Susan Stockwell. Key Vocabulary: Imaginary, Shape, Texture, Felt, Abstract, Curator

DT

We will be designing, making and evaluating a chair for Baby Bear. We will explore how to make a strong structure. Key vocabulary: structure, man-made, natural, function

Geography

In geography we will identify which country and continent our school is in and will learn the names of all seven continents. We will also explore what physical and human features are in our town. Key vocabulary: settlement, United Kingdom, Human Features, Physical Features, Continent.

History

We will learn about the history of toys and will compare toys from the past and present to see how they have changed over time. Key Vocabulary: past, present, modern, timeline, favourite, popular

Computing.

We will learn how to program and direct a virtual Bee-Bot and how to edit photos using a computer/tablet. Key Vocabulary: Algorithm, Bee-Bot, Code, Explore, precise, video
