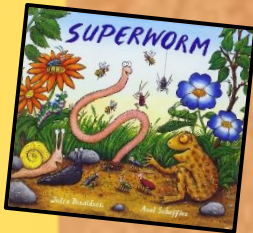


KS1 Autumn Term 2025-2026

English

This term we are going to be reading the text, Superworm and using this to inspire our writing. We will produce a range of different types of texts and learn how to write sentences remembering to include capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will also continue to learn our monster phonics sounds.



Jigsaw/PHSCE

Our jigsaw topics this term are being me in my world and celebrating difference.

Key vocabulary: rights, responsibilities, rewards, consequences, similarities differences.

Music

In Music we will explore pitch and tempo and create a musical intro for a hero or a villain

Key vocabulary: body percussion, pitch, tempo, instrument, perform, play, pulse, rhythm.

RE

In RE we will learn all about Hindu worship and the Christian festival, Christmas. Key vocabulary: Mandir, Nativity, Bethlehem, Deities Mantras, Vedas, Murti, Christian.

PE

In PE we will explore attack and defence games, teambuilding, gymnastics and dance.

Mathematics

Y1: We will be learning the place value of numbers to 20 and exploring how many tens and ones they contain. Next we will learn how to add and subtract numbers within 10. We will also learn to recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes.

Y2: We will be learning the place value of numbers to 100 and exploring how many tens and ones they contain. Next we will add and subtract numbers beginning with one -digit and progressing to using two, two-digit numbers. We will also be learning the 10, 2 and 5 times tables.

Science

In Science we will learn about a variety of everyday materials including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard, and will identify their suitability for particular uses. We will also learn all about plants this term and will label the key parts of a plant. Key vocabulary: fragile, waterproof, hard, soft, flower, plant, evergreen

Art

In art, we will be developing our drawing skills. We will learn how to draw different types of lines, using different media, inspired by the artist, Bridget Riley. Key Vocabulary: cross hatch, horizontal, vertical, line, observe, texture.

DT

We will be learning all about stable structures. We will design, make and evaluate a pencil pot, ensuring that it meets the design criteria. Key vocabulary: structure, stable, freestanding

Geography

In geography, we will learn all about Mexico, and compare this with our country, England. We will discover what continent both countries are located in and discuss their physical and human features. Key vocabulary: atlas, globe, equator, capital city, Union Jack.

History

Our history topic this term is changes in technology. We will learn all about how technology has changed the way we talk, write and are entertained, within the last 60 years.

Key Vocabulary: technology, devices, typewriter, rotary telephone, cassettes.

Computing.

In computing this term, we will be developing our mouse skills by learning how to drag and click. Also, we will learn how to write computer algorithms. Key Vocabulary: mouse, screen, left-click, algorithm, bug, debug.
