
KS1 Spring Term 2024-2025 Hera Class



English

This term we are going to be reading the text Lila and the Secret of Rain and using this to inspire our writing. We will produce a range of different types of texts and learn how to write sentences with growing accuracy and complexity. We will whee also continue to learn and revise our monster phonics sounds.





Jiasaw/PHSCE

Our jigsaw topics this term are Dreams and Goals and Healthy Me.

Key vocabulary: achievement, goal, healthy, unhealthy, nutrients, balanced diet Music

We will explore pictorial representations of rhythm show sounds and rests.

In RE, will learn about Our Wonderful World. Key Vocabulary: Hindu, Christian, creation, heaven, Brahma, world, lotus flower

In P.E will we explore team games involving following rules, and will later move onto gymnastics exploring wide, narrow and curled

Mathematics

Y1: In maths, we will be learning all about the place value of numbers to 50, and how to add and subtract numbers within 20. Later will move onto measurement, where we will learn how to measure <u>length</u> and height in centimetres. We will also learn about mass and volume.

Y2: We will learn all about money including how to find change and calculate using money. We will also learn how to multiply and divide, focusing on our 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables. Later, we will learn about measuring length and height in metres/centimetres and measuring mass and capacity in grams/kilograms and millilitres/litres.

Science

Our science topic this term is living things and their habitats. We will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. We will also learn all about food chains. Key vocabulary: alive, dead, living, conditions, adapted.

DT We will be designing, making and evaluating a fairground wheel. We will explore how to make a mechanism. Key vocabulary; strong, weak, stable, evaluation



Art

In art we will be learning about painting and exploring colour mixing after looking at Jasper John's and Clarice Cliff's work. Key Vocabulary: primary and secondary colours

Geography

In geography we will be studying the unit Our Local Park. Key vocabulary: route, human and physical features. data collection methods. History

We will learn about kings, queens and
