FREE REVISION BOOKS, AFTER SCHOOL BOOSTER SESSIONS AND Y6 SATS INFORMATION

Dear Parent / Carer

With the end of Key Stage 2 tests fast approaching for Year 6 pupils, it is critical that we – school and home - prepare them as much as possible prior to testing in May 2023.

We, at the 'Academy', have sourced a series of revision booklets designed to help you to support your child's learning in the areas of Reading, Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling and Maths.

Each set of books has cost the academy over £30 for each child and we are providing these resources to you for 'FREE'!

Children have all been provided with a set of revision books today. All pupils have been given the 'Achieve 100 – The Expected Standard' books and some pupils will also have been given the 'Achieve 110 – The Higher Score' books for mathematics and GPS or both. Two books are provided for each subject. Pupils are only to write in and complete the tasks from the book with a tick on the front. The other book is to be used as a guide only.





These need returning by the end of May
Complete the tasks in these books (has a tick)

Pupils will be expected to complete the following each week:

Monday - One reading comprehension from the Achieve 100 book

Tuesday – One spelling task from the Achieve 100 book (and one from the Achieve 110 book if you have it) These are found at the back of the Grammar and Punctuation books.

Wednesday – **Two pages from the Achieve 100 mathematics book** (plus two pages from the Achieve 110 book if you have it)

Thursday – **Two pages from the Achieve 100 Grammar and Punctuation** book (plus two pages from the Achieve 110 book if you have it.)

All task books come with answer pages and pupils/parents are to self-mark their own work. This will give instant feedback to pupils about their progress and whether there are any issues from the task. Please cut out the answers and store them safely before pupils complete their first tasks.

Once tasks have been completed, this needs to be recorded on the attached SATS Revision Record Sheet alongside any issues pupils may have had which can be addressed in school. The SATS Revision Record Sheet needs to signed each week and handed in to class teachers/TA's on a Friday morning. Periodically, once every four weeks, we will also be collecting in the booster books in which pupils are undertaking tasks to check understanding and that tasks are being completed fully. These dates are found on the task completion sheet.

Provision will be made during morning break times for any pupils unable to complete the workbooks at home to ensure they do not fall behind and miss out on any learning opportunities.

To clarify:

- The guides and pupil answer books do not need to be returned to school each week for marking as marking sheets are provided for you to check your child's answers:
- We merely ask that you return your child's revision record sheet on a weekly basis (FRIDAY) and any areas they may have struggled with;
- We ask you start at the beginning of each book and work your way through it with pupils using the number of pages stated above;
- Books will be asked to be returned every 4 weeks so that we can monitor the success of pupils and identify any further issues with learning.

After School Booster Sessions

Alongside the revision books, we have found in the past that after school booster sessions, tailored to the needs of the pupils, are an effective method of boosting attainment and confidence. To this end, we shall be running after school mathematics and reading booster sessions after school on a Tuesday and Wednesday evening from 3:20pm – 4:15pm in Theseus, Artemis and Achilles classrooms, starting on the week beginning 31st January 2023. The aim of the booster sessions are to address any issues which may have arisen in class and plug gaps in learning. Pupils must be collected from their classroom door unless it has been specifically stated that they are to walk home alone on the attached permission sheet.
