School Crossing Patrol on Trinity Road/Richmond Road

Dear Parent / Carer,

Following the return of a School Crossing Patrol Officer near the junction of Trinity Road and Richmond Road, we would like to remind you of the enforcement restrictions outside our academy so you are not subject to a penalty charge notice and also so that the new School Crossing Patrol Officer has a clear view of the road to cross pedestrians:

1. **Yellow zig zag lines outside schools:** These indicate the length of road where stopping is strictly prohibited during the times shown on the upright sign. In the case of Thrunscoe Academy, vehicles must not stop on these markings from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8-9am and 3-4pm. Any vehicle which is observed to be stopped on the zig zag lines will receive an instant Penalty Charge Notice. The zig zag lines are there to **safeguard children's lives as they allow there to be a clear view of the road.**
2. **Double Yellow Lines:** Parking is prohibited on double yellow lines at any time although you may stop to load or unload or drop off a passenger. However, this should only be where the driver feels it is safe to do so and the vehicle should only be stopped for as long as it takes to get the passenger in or out of the vehicle. If parents wish to accompany their child into school we would strongly advise they park in a location that is not subject to any parking restrictions, in order to avoid receiving a Penalty Charge Notice.
3. **Parking a vehicle fully or partially across a dropped kerb is classed as an obstruction and either the police or local council can enforce the contravention.**

For safety, could we please remind you to wait until the School Crossing Patrol Officer makes sure it is safe to cross the road and walk in front of her so she can see you at all times.
