We will continue to develop our appreciation and understanding that all people are different to each other.

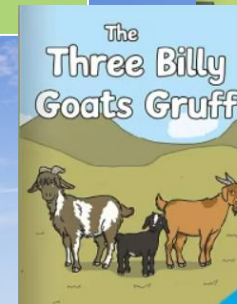
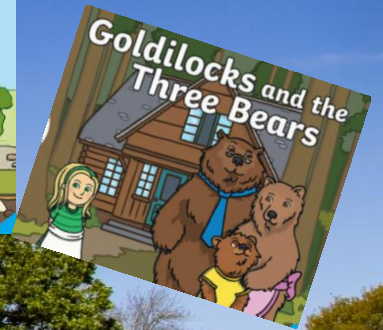
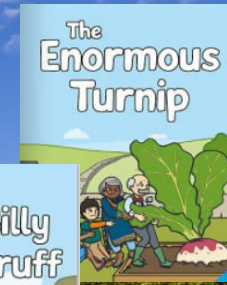
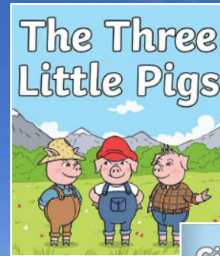
Maths
