Theseus Class Curriculum Map Spring 2025

English

Our class book for this term will be 'Cosmic', which tells the story of an eleven-year-old boy, who competes with a group of adults for a chance to go into space.

We will start by exploring the book through role play, inference, exploring dilemmas and much more, before moving on to deconstructing the text and further developing GPS skills. We will then construct a debate on whether man really did go to the moon and also write a description of an imaginary planet.

Computing

We will complete our unit on spreadsheets, which will involve the children using Microsoft Excel. Pupils will also use Excel to create a pixel art picture.

RE

The children will explore the Jewish faith in RE lessons. Pupils will explore Jewish festivals and the traditions that followers have.

Spanish

The children will recap on basic skills such as being able to say their name, age and express opinions about food. This will progress onto speaking about hobbies and pastimes.

Science

The units of 'Earth and Space' will include exploring Earth and the features that make Earth habitable. We will then explore other planets, stars and the role of the moon and sun. Pupils will also focus on identifying the different phases of the moon and look at how shadows change position throughout the day..

PE

We will continue to refine our invasion skills, built upon through the Autumn term. We will then move onto completing a gym unit involving balancing and symmetry. Pupils will also be given the opportunity to access a variety of extra-curricular sports clubs and participate in different competitions.

PSHE

Using the 'JIGSAW' approach, we will explore our dreams and goals for the future. We will then move on to looking at the human body and establishing how we can keep our mind, souls and physical body healthy.

<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be focusing on fractions, decimals, percentages and multiplication and division. We will start by looking at equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and converting fractions into decimals and percentages. We will then move on to improving our reasoning and problem solving skills. Other areas of mathematics we will cover include: translation, reflections, co-ordinates, 2-D and 3-D shapes, bar and line graphs and pie charts.

There will also be the opportunity for some **Year 6 pupils** to access mathematics tutoring sessions after school, beginning in February 2025.
