**Year 5/6 Visit to the National Space Centre, Leicester  
Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2023**

As part of our space topic this term, we would like to offer an extraordinary experience to the children of Artemis, Achilles and Theseus classes: an amazing visit to The National Space Centre in Leicester! The visit will include intriguing workshops about 'Life in Space' led by Space Centre Experts, being fully immersed into the universe within The Planetarium attraction and the opportunity to explore the history of space travel and 'The Space Race' within the centre.

On Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2023, the children will need to be at school for 7.50am. We will then depart the school promptly. The coach is due to return back to school at approximately 5.30pm (we will update parents by text on the day of any changes to the return time due to traffic etc). Your child will need a packed lunch and a drink (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please!). If your child has a free school meal and you would like to order them a packed lunch for the day then please login to Chartwells and order the packed lunch option by **Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> February**.

Children will need to wear their school uniform with sensible footwear and a coat. If your child requires a travel sickness tablet please administer before they arrive at school. Any tablets necessary for the return journey must be in a named envelope and handed to a teacher or teaching assistant.

The total cost per child of this visit (including insurance, coach travel, entrance to the Space Centre, Workshops and Planetarium Show) is just over £25.00. We recognise that this is a lot of money and because we are committed to giving your child the very best first hand experiences to help bring their learning to life, the academy has taken the decision to subsidise the cost by £12.00 per pupil. This reduces the cost to you to only £13.00, which we feel is giving excellent value for money. If you are unsure about how to do this, please contact the academy office.
