# Academy Results 2016

At the end of each key stage, the government requires every school and academy to assess the level of attainment that each child has achieved.

Phonics Screening test take place in the month of June during year 1.

Key stage 1 assessments are made towards the end of year 2.

Key stage 2 assessments take place in the month of May during year 6.

These assessments are more commonly known as SATs (Standard Attainment Tests).

## Early Years Foundation Stage

The number of pupils achieving a good level of progress at the end of Reception in 2016 was 73% (69%).

## Year 1 Phonics Screening

The number of pupils achieving the expected standard in 2016 was 86% (81%).
