World Book Day

Tor View will celebrate World Book Day on Thursday 4th March. Whether pupils are at home or in school, there are lots of fun learning activities planned to nurture and instil a love and joy of reading. This year our celebration will be bigger and better than ever! Starting from Monday, pupils will have the opportunity to engage with games, craft activities and external events, building up to Thursday.

The Masked Reader: From Monday to Wednesday a 'masked reader' will read an extract from their favourite book. Pupils are to guess which member of staff they think is reading, with an unmasking each day at 3 pm.

Window Decoration & Book Hunt: Either at home or in school, pupils are being asked to decorate a window as the book cover of their favourite text.
