Free School Meals & Pupil Premium

Information for Parents



Which pupils qualify for Free School Meals?

Your child may be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) if you receive any of the following:

- Income support
- Income—based Jobseekers Allowance or Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on
- Universal Tax Credit

In addition, schools must provide Free School Meals to all pupils in Reception, Year 1 & 2. This is known as Universal Infant Free School Meals

What are the benefits of claiming Free School Meals?

School meals are a good way to ensure that your child eats well at lunchtime and can also save you time and money.

If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, they may also be entitled to a sum of money which is paid to school to boost their learning.

What is Pupil Premium?

The Pupil Premium Grant is funding provided to schools to help all pupils reach their full potential, regardless of their background or financial situation.

Pupils may be eligible if they:

- Are registered for Free School Meals
- Have been registered for Free School Meals at any point within the last six years.
- Are or have been in care
- Have parents in the armed

How is Pupil Premium Funding used?

The Pupil Premium is not used to pay for school meals. Schools use the funding to improve the attainment and welfare of pupils.
