

SHAPE & FORM

A <u>shape</u> is an area enclosed by a <u>line</u>. It could be just an outline or it could be <u>shaded</u> in.

Form is a three dimensional shape such as a sphere, cube or a cone.


FORMAL ELEMENTS

TEXTURE

<u>Texture</u> is the surface quality of something, the way something feels or looks like it feels. There are two types of texture: <u>Actual Texture</u> and <u>Visual Texture</u>.

<u>Actual Texture</u> really exists so you can feel it or touch it

Visual Texture—created using different marks to represent actual texture.



COLOUR

There are 3 Primary Colours:
RED, YELLOW and BLUE.

By mixing any two <u>Primary Colours</u> together we get a <u>Secondary Colour</u>;



PATTERN

<u>pattern</u> is a design that is created by repeating <u>lines</u>, <u>shapes</u>, <u>tones</u> or <u>colours</u>.

<u>Patterns</u> can be <u>manmade</u>, like a <u>design</u> on fabric, or <u>natural</u>, such as the markings on animal fur.

Chalk





Tone means the lightness and darkness of something.

Value - range of light to dark

The tone gives different degrees of lightness and darkness.

This can be created by;

- Use a pencil on its side
- Press gently at first
- Press harder to make a darker tone
- This makes objects look real and solid
- It turns them into 3D objects.





There are three PRIMARY colours - red, yellow, blue Mixing colours;


By mixing two primary colours together, we get a secondary colour

Red + Yellow = Orange


Yellow + Blue = Green


