Macbeth

William Shakespeare (adapted by Catherine Woolley)

Macbeth and his friend Banquo were brave soldiers.

Visual/Vestibular: cardboard/plastic shiny sword, play fight as appropriate.

Three witches said, "All hail Macbeth, thou shalt be King hereafter!"

Visual/Proprioception: look at/wear a witch's hat.

Auditory/Proprioception: press switch to hear quote in witch's voice

Lady Macbeth gave the guards wine to make them sleep.

Taste/Smell: grape or pomegranate juice in plastic goblet (one for each learner).

"Is this a dagger which I see before me, The handle toward my hand?"

Visual/Tactile: explore small dagger (plastic, wooden or cardboard)

Macbeth was the new king, but he was worried.

Tactile/Proprioception: explore/wear crown

"Double double toil and trouble, fire burn and cauldron bubble".

Visual: cauldron with liquid in.

Proprioception/Tactile: stir liquid in cauldron with circular movements.

The witches told him he would be king "until Birnam Wood remove to Dunsinane" castle.

Smell: pine essential oil OR Tactile/Smell: pine branch

"Out damned spot! Out I say!" Lady Macbeth kept washing her hands to get them clean.

Tactile/Smell: wash hands in a bowl of scented/soapy water



Irlacautt alsguised his soldiers with branches trom trees and his army got into the castle.

Visual/Tactile: explore/hide behind branches from a real tree (with leaves on if possible)

Malcolm, Duncan's son, was crowned the new King of Scotland.

Auditory: Scottish national anthem.
