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CD Fish

Supplies

- PVA glue
- Coloured foam
- 2 Old CDs
- Ribbon
- Sticky tape
- Sequins and jewels
- Googly eyes



- 1 Draw 2 fins, a tail piece and lips onto the coloured foam. Then cut the foam shapes out using scissors.



- 2 Tie a length of ribbon into a loop. Then tape this onto the non-shiny side of one of the disks.



- 3 Using PVA glue, stick the fins, tail and lips onto the non-shiny side of the CD. Do this so that they hang over the edge.



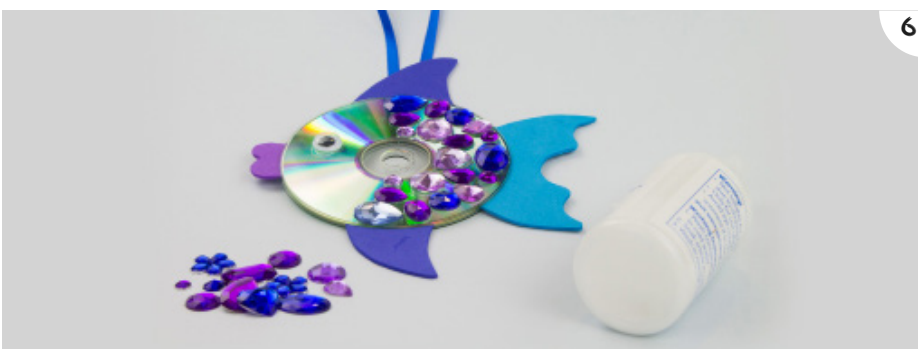
- 4 Take the second CD and spread PVA glue on the non-shiny side of it. Then stick this onto the back of the other CD, so that both shiny sides are visible.



- 5 Using PVA glue, stick a googly eye just above the fish's lips on both sides.



- 6 Now decorate both sides of the fish. To do this, stick sequins and jewels on using small amounts of PVA glue.
