Project 6 = Copy Pablo Picasso's 'The Girl in the Mirror'



Why? – Why are you doing this and what am I looking for?


Access- Draw a portrait using straight lines/use mark making skills you have learnt to improve fine motor skills/hold art tools correctly

Project 9 = Front View/tilted head/looking upwards/life like drawing then add tone using a pencil.






