Dear Parent/Guardian,

This year, our main transition days for all our new intake of Year 7 students will be Tuesday 25th and Wednesday 26th June. Students should arrive at Tottington High School between 8.00am-8.30am and students will finish at 2.45pm on both days.

These days are a very important part of the transition as they will give your child a chance to spend 2 days getting to know their new school prior to starting full time in September.

The days are designed to be fun but informative and will provide opportunities to explore the school site, meet new classmates and experience lessons. We will inform your child's primary school of their attendance with us on both days. Your child should attend the transition days in their primary school uniform, with a bag containing trainers (for the Wednesday only), sun cream, a water bottle, packed lunch and a pencil case/stationery for lessons.

We very much understand that the transition process is not only important for students, but for parents and carers too. This year we will be holding a welcome evening for new parents and carers at 6.30pm on Monday 24th June, we ask parents to arrive from 6.00pm onwards. The evening will involve a short presentation by the Headteacher on aspects of school life at Tottington High School and will give you an opportunity to meet with key members of staff, where they will introduce themselves and talk through the September start.

Parking will be available at the back of the school, where the gates will be open for you to park on the school grounds.
