Dear Parent/Carer

I hope that this letter finds you safe and well.

I am writing to inform you about the Year 11 intervention programme that will be starting after February half term. We want to give students the best opportunities to achieve their potential in all subjects and in light of the current situation, students still need to be working hard to display their progress while working remotely. Staff have been working extremely hard to provide an extensive remote curriculum, and we are now in a position where we are able to offer some specific subject intervention (via Microsoft Teams) for students 'after school' 3pm – 4pm. This will begin on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February.

Students will receive an individualised timetable for their after school intervention. Students have been selected based on their mock exam results, in-class assessments and overall attitude to learning. We hope this will give students the opportunity to engage with their teachers on a more one to one basis and improve their skills, knowledge and confidence and overall attainment within that specific subject.

It is expected that your son/daughter will attend and attendance will be monitored. Each subject intervention will run for three weeks at a time, at the end of which, pupils will do a mini assessment to ascertain whether their knowledge and understanding of the subject has improved.
