

Origami

First you need to make a square of paper from an A4 piece of paper.

The instructions to do this are;



Step 1: Get out a regular 8½x11 paper.



Step 2: Take the left corner and fold it down to the right side. Make sure the right corner is creased at the very tip.



Step 3: Take the upper right corner and fold it down to the left, connecting the corner to the left corner where the original fold was made.



Step 4: Fold the bottom rectangle backwards and crease it well by using your fingernails to run along the edge.



Step 5: Unfold the rectangle to its original position.



Step 6: Unfold the whole paper.



Step 7: Cut out the bottom rectangle or if you creased it really well with your fingernails, you can tear it off.

To tear off, place the paper flat on a table and with each hand firmly placed on the rectangle and the rest of the paper, slowly spread the pieces apart.



Step 8: Now you have a perfect square ready for origami!

Origami Dog

Step 1: Start with a square piece of [origami paper](#).



Step 2: Fold the top corner to the bottom corner.



Step 3: Now fold the triangle in half by folding the left corner to the right corner.



Step 4: Unfold it.



Step 5: Fold both corners of the triangle down at an angle like in the picture. These are the ears!



Step 6: Fold the top corner to the back, so the head is not pointy.



Step 7: Fold the bottom corner back also unless you prefer a pointy chin.



Step 8: Now draw on the eyes and nose. Now you have your simple origami dog!

Origami Rocket

Step 1: Start with a square sheet of [origami paper](#),



Step 2: Fold the paper in half, left to right, and unfold.



Step 3: Now fold the paper in half again, top to bottom, and unfold again.



Step 4: Fold the top edge to the center.

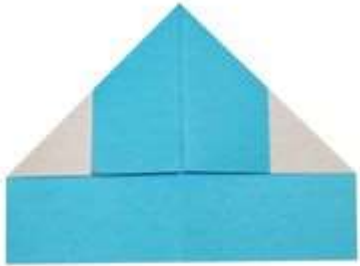


Step 5: Turn the paper over.





Step 6: Fold the top left and right corners to meet at the middle



Step 7: Fold the left and right edges to meet at the middle. We'll fold out these flaps next.





Step 8: Fold about 2/3rds (two thirds) of the left and right flaps out.



Step 9: Turn the figure over and now you have a rocket!
