

## Riddles

A riddle is a word puzzle. For example- What begins with an 'e' and ends with an 'e' but only has 1 letter? Answer - Envelope

Another example - What can you hold without touching it? Answer- your breath.

To work out the answers to the riddles you will have to think 'out of the box' some are designed to trick you.
