Home School Agreement

What the school will do;

For your child:-

- Care for their physical, emotional and intellectual safety and happiness.
- Encourage them to achieve the very best they can and reach their full potential.
- Value them as a member of the school community.
- Provide a balanced curriculum which meets their individual needs.
- Expect high standards of work and behaviour.
- Build good, working relationships which enable the children to be effective learners.
- Develop a sense of responsibility for themselves and others.

For you:-

- Keep you informed about all general matters which effect your child's education.
- Update you regularly about your child's progress and attainment.
- Be open and welcoming and listen to any concerns that you may have.
- Offer you opportunities to be involved in the daily life of the school.



What you can do for your child:-

- Be interested and involved with what your child does at school.
- Complete all work which is sent home as part of home learning.
- Read with your child daily.
- Attend parent progress meetings termly to discuss your child's progress.
- Support the schools policy for behaviour in school and on the playground.
- Ensure that your child attends school regularly, on time and do not take holidays in term time.
- Inform the school on the first day of absence stating the reason your child is away.
- Ensure that your child is collected on time at the end of the day.
- Inform the school of any changes, concerns or problems that might affect your child's education, work or behaviour, including contact numbers.
- Support the school in keeping your child and the wider school community healthy.



What your child can do:-

- Attend school every day, on time and be ready to learn.
- Be polite, respectful, use good manners and be helpful to all members of our school.
- Do all their class work and home learning as well as they can
- Always try their best, take risks and never give up.
- Listen to teachers and children, taking notice of what is said.
- Behave appropriately and follow the schools golden rules.
- Look after the school environment and be eco friendly.
- Work well with others and be able to co-operate with children in teams.
- Remember that everyone has the right to learn and not to distract others from their learning.
- Be enthusiastic about learning and have an inquisitive nature to find out new information.



Use of Photography/ Technology

We have a number of events and occasions in school when you, as parents, are able to take photographs/ videos of your child. We know that recording these special events is important to parents as it provides a record of your child growing up.

However there are certain criteria that we need you to agree to so that the children are safeguarded:-

- All photography and videoing should be quiet, discreet and not block anyone else's view.
- That you will only photograph/ video your child.
- That no images are posted on any social networking sites or on the Internet in any shape or form.
- That you will not use social networking sites to post any derogatory or slanderous remarks about members of staff, other parents or children.
