
Thank you to Mrs Oakley who has kindly donated her lottery winnings back to school.

Our Year 5 and Year 6 School council members together with their peers from Christ Church, Park and West Street Primary schools form Colne Junior Council.


Together they are helping raise money for the Open Door in Colne by recycling old/used aluminium cans.
