There will be a non-uniform day on **Friday 3rd July** in exchange for the children bringing as many items as they can for their class stall.

Class stalls and requested donations are as follows:-

- **EYFS Anything Red Tombola** – any type of red item to go on a tombola stall
- **Year 1 Chocolate Tombola** – any type of chocolate large or small (box, bar, biscuit etc)
- **Year 2 Bottle Tombola** – any type of bottle (ketchup, shampoo, wine, sauce, cordial etc)

Trawden Sports Week - wb 22nd June

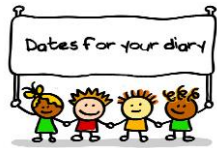


We are holding a fun packed Sports Week again this year. We are holding so many different activities including Sports Day!

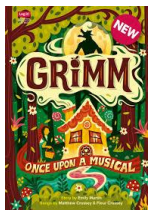
