Children's Mental Health Week

From 7-11th February, we will be participating in Children's Mental Health Week 2022.



This year's theme is 'Growing Together '.

We grow intellectually as we gain new knowledge, skills, and understanding at school, and beyond. 'Growing Together' is about growing emotionally, and finding ways to help each other grow.

For Children's Mental Health Week 2022, Place2Be is encouraging children (and adults) to consider how they have grown, what they need to help them grow, and how they can help others to grow too.

Each class will take part in different activities across the week and we will showcase our work on the displays in the corridor. We will also be having a non-uniform day on Friday 11th February. The theme for this day is 'Dress to Express' where the children can wear clothes of their choice to express their feelings or personality. Please ensure that this clothing is appropriate for school and, for health and safety reasons, no heels.

World Book Day 2022 'You are a reader!'

World Book Day (3rd March 2022) is a really important way in which we can encourage more children to be readers – your work on this day and every day make it happen!

Did you spot 2 of our Eco-Warriors, William & Georgie, in the Colne Times on Christmas Eve?

Pendle Council wanted to share 'good news' stories. They came into school to learn all about our plans for our new polytunnel -funded by Pendle Borough Council.

We are very proud of our Eco Warriors, they help to care for our school environment: they monitor our energy use in the school and encourage teachers and children to recycle. Eco Warriors will take part in discussions and votes and feedback any relevant information to their class. Members will meet regularly with Miss Lambert to discuss their ideas.

Being an Eco Warrior is an ideal opportunity for our pupils to get more involved in the way our school is run and help us to be more environmentally friendly. It provides opportunities for pupils to communicate their feelings as well as influence decisions that are made. Eco Warriors take on the responsibility of expressing their own views, but also the views of their peers as well as passing on information from eco meetings. As an Eco Warrior pupils have the opportunity to develop skills such as confidence, communication and negotiation.
