## Learning:

Our topic for the first half term is 'A Stroll through the Seasons'.

During this topic, children will learn about the different seasons and how weather conditions change. In Science, we will be focusing on human senses before moving on to learning about the body parts and eating habits of animals. We will be making some visits to the field for Forest School so please see the dates at the end to know when to bring Forest School waterproofs in.

#### Homework:

<u>Tasks:</u> Every Friday your child will be set homework on Seesaw / MyMaths. Your child will be shown how to complete the task in class before attempting to complete it at home.

Spellings: We will share ten words linked to a spelling rule we have been practising in class for your child to learn each week. There will also be an additional 1-2 common exception words, which will not be linked to the spelling rule practised. There will be a spelling test the following Friday for children to show what they have

Reading: Due to current restrictions, we will only be changing books once a week (Thursday) when the children will be given two books to read at home. Please access reading in other ways such as through local libraries, books you have at home and <a href="https://www.lovereading4kids.co.uk/">www.lovereading4kids.co.uk/</a> which enables you to access a range of books online for free. However, you will need to sign up for a free account first. Please support your child at home by listening to them read daily. If you would like to share something about your child's reading with us, please do so via Seesaw.

### Reminders:

**Dinners:** School dinners this half term will be 'packed lunch' style with children being offered a hot dinner on Monday, Wednesday and Friday and sandwiches on Tuesday and Thursday. Children will be able to choose their lunch from a set menu each week.

**Water**: Please ensure that your child has a bottle of water every day, labelled with their name, to keep them hydrated throughout the day and to drink with their lunch. We are no longer able to provide the children with cups from school.

**Snack:** They can bring in a healthy afternoon snack, which must be kept in their coat pocket or book bag.

**P.E kits:** We will be doing PE outside as much as possible so please ensure that your child has the appropriate kit for this. Their kit can remain in school for the half term.

**Mornings:** Thank you for sticking to our start time and getting the children to school promptly each morning. It allows us to start our phonics sessions in a timely manner and therefore maximise the children's learning.

**Forest School:** Please bring waterproof clothing and wellies on the Forest School dates (please see timetable below). This could be a waterproof all-in-one suit or separate waterproof trousers and coat. This will make it easier for the children to put on over their school uniform and mean that they will not need to get changed in school.

Library and Reading Books: Please could you return any school books from last year as soon as possible.
