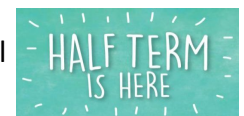

Attendance

Punctuality and good attendance is an important factor in your child's education. When children miss days of school they are always 'playing catch up' with that day (or week's) learning.

LCC:- *Did you know, that being just 15 minutes late each morning means your child would miss the equivalent of 10 days from school each year.*

We understand that illness and some days off are inevitable but please try and avoid unessential absences if at all possible.

An absence request form **must** be completed for holidays or other planned absences. Fines may come into force if holiday's taken in school time are deemed excessive.

LCC:- *For every week of school a child misses, they lose 25 hours of education which can never be regained.*
