The Government has put Pendle under the highest tier of restrictions in England, Tier 3, which means we have **NEW RESTRICTIONS** we must follow. But we can all play a part in Pendle moving to a lower tier, with less restrictions.

The new Tier 3 restrictions mean that:

- You still cannot socialise indoors with people you don't live with, except for someone in your support bubble
- You can now meet in a group of up to six people in outdoor public spaces like parks, but don't hug or shake hands with anyone you don't live with!
- Shops, leisure centres, gyms, hairdressers, barbers and beauticians can open.

There is help for you and your family! And safe vaccines are rolling out so that we can look forward to a safer year in 2021.

- Food shopping, prescriptions and support for people self-isolating
