Attendance and punctuality

has been mentioned on this newsletter a couple of times.

On Monday your child will be



bringing home a coloured attendance letter - in line with DfE guidelines. These letters are usually sent out after every full term, the letter you will receive will include the % attendance for your child for over the last 2 terms (September 2017-March 2018).

FACTS

- *90% attendance is equivalent to a full month off school a year!
- *There are 190 statutory school days in one year. That means there are 175 days (weekends & school holidays) available to use for holidays!
- *Headteachers cannot authorise any leave in term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.
- *If you take your child on a 2 week holiday in term time, attendance for the year immediately drops to 95%.
- *Missing just 10 minutes of school a day is the same as missing two weeks over the year.
