Y1:- Live slot 9.15-9.45am daily

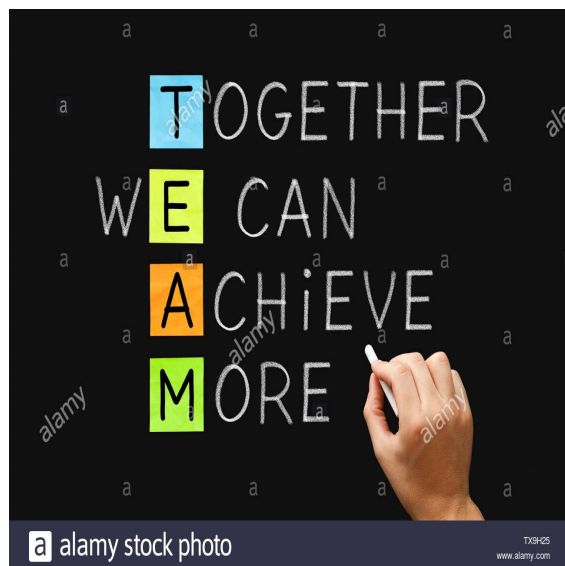
Y2:- Live slot 10.00-10.30am daily

Renaissance –Accelerated Reader

Pupils in Keystage 2 use accelerated reader as a tool to support their reading skills. Star quizzes are completed when pupils finish reading a book to confirm their understanding of the content.
