The qualities and skills that governors need:

- * a strong commitment to the role and this includes dedicating your time regularly during each the school term and throughout the year to carrying out your duties.
- * a strong commitment to making sure there are high aspirations for the all the children in your school and a commitment to achieving the best possible outcomes for all the pupils.
- * to be naturally inquisitive and have the ability to question and analyse, and a willingness to learn.
- * good inter-personal skills.
- * the skills to understand the particular ethos of the school and its implications for the way it is governed.


