Thursday 24th May - open session 2.45-3.20pm

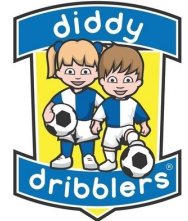
School will be open for parents to come and view the amazing work that the children have completed during their topic lessons this term.

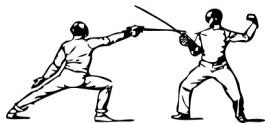
