We are taking part in the "WOW – the walk to school challenge!"

This is a pupil-led challenge where the children self-report how they get to school every day. The exciting behaviour-change initiative to encourage more children and their families to walk to school.

If they travel sustainably at least once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge. If you live too far away or don't have time to walk the whole way to school, you can Park and Stride to help your child earn their WOW badge. Simply park or hop off public transport at least ten minutes away from the school and walk the remaining journey.
