#### **Birthdays**

Our topic until Christmas is 'Extreme Explorers'. This half-term will include:

**English** – Non-Chronological Reports about the First Moon Landing, Animal Adventure Stories and Poems on a Theme.

**Maths –** Addition and Subtraction, 2D & 3D Shape, Counting, Multiplication and Sorting, Statistics, Fractions, Money and Time

**Science** – We will be focussing on looking after ourselves by learning about germs and bacteria, hand washing, how to clean our teeth and medicines.

**Art –** We will be creating works of art inspired by Keith Haring. We will be really focussing on creating imagines of people using the correct proportions for limbs.

**Computing –** Mr Irvine will be focussing on Online Safety and an introduction to spreadsheets.

**PE** – ProSport will be teaching the children about Basic Skills i.e. throwing, catching, kicking, etc.

**PSHE** – We will be learning about the importance of hygiene and safety.

**RE** – We will be looking at Christianity, the creation story, advent at Christmas and the significance of Christmas lights.

**Music –** We will be learning to perform all of our Nativity songs ready for the performance in December.

## Reading / Reading Books

Reading is extremely important to your child's education and children need to show they can read the words in a book and show their understanding of each book. Please read with your child on a daily basis and ensure that they take home and bring in their yellow reading record and reading book on a daily basis.

Every child will have the opportunity to read with Miss Hart, Mrs Stevenson (volunteer) or myself each week. When we have read with your child, we will write a short comment in their yellow reading record for you to see (providing they have brought it into school).

In Year 2, we will be changing reading books twice a week on **Mondays** and **Thursdays**, <u>providing a comment has been written in their reading record and children bring their books into the classroom</u>. Please also *record any other books that your child has chosen to read* at home or the library to help us celebrate their love of reading.
