

Make a leaf picture. Collect leaves to create prints using paint or rubbings with crayons.

#### 5. Green Fingers

Plant and grow a plant, vegetable or flower.

#### 2. Forest Creatures

#### **Rules and Conditions**

An entry slip must be filled in for each entry. Judging will take place on **Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> June.** Prizes will be awarded for each category. Entries should be children's work with only minimal adult help. All entries will be exhibited after judging.
