Wow! This week has flown by—January always feels like the longest month of the year and it is already drawing to a close.

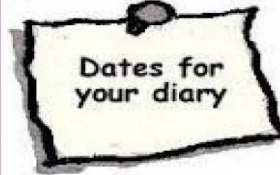
All our year groups are back into the swing of things, after our PHSE week, last week. Keep an eye on our diary dates and Facebook page as we have so many exciting things happening in school.

If you have any issues or queries—please don't hesitate to pop in to school to see us. Our door is always open.

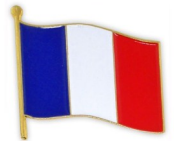
