Science Fair entry:- children must complete a test, survey, or experiment using something that will benefit the planet in the future i.e. forces, weather, animals, environment, health. They should ensure they are interested as it could take many days to complete. This is a home project, therefore it will need to all be completed out of school before our Science Fair.

Submit videos on Seesaw by Thur 11th March. Judging is on Fri 12th March. Winners announced on Mon 15th March.

Theme: Innovating for the Future

You can choose any topic linked to something that will benefit the planet in the future i.e. forces, weather, animals, environment, health, etc. to complete your investigation.

Your project should be completed at home.

World Book Day 2021 Thursday 4th March

World Book Day is coming and as with everything, we're doing things a little bit differently this year. We will be 'Sharing a story' with the children at home and at school, within our class Zoom sessions and there will also be additional extra special teacher Zoom reading sessions too! So, despite us currently being apart we can still all come together to enjoy our love of stories as the theme this year is...

SHARE A STORY, ANYTIME, ANYWHERE!

Therefore, our focus is on sharing a story with each other (not dressing up).

Did you know that 'reading for pleasure is the single biggest indicator for success in life, more than family circumstances, educational background, or income' (source:- Organisation for Economic Co-operation & Development)?

'Get Caught Reading' competition:- Reading for pleasure can happen anywhere, anytime. It's just about finding the right book, graphic novel, audio book or digital book, finding a lovely spot to read and getting on with it. That's why we are also holding a 'Get Caught Reading' competition. Check out your child's Seesaw activity to see how to get involved.

Sharing a story Zoom times:- Each class teacher has organised lots of exciting activities for you to complete at home for World Book Day.
