In Year 3, our topic for this half-term is 'We Will Rock You' which will certainly be a "rocky ride'! Within this topic, we shall be learning about rocks.

In our science work, we shall geographical work, we shall investigate volcanoes and earthquakes.

This half-term, we will also be doing PE outdoors as long as the weather permits. Please ensure that your child has trainers as well as black pumps. You could send trainers in to keep in your child's PE bag or send them in each Friday for the day.



For Forest School, please ensure that your child brings a pair of wellies or walking boots. The weather will now become wetter and colder so they will also need waterproof clothing, a hat and gloves as well as a pair or two of thicker socks and plenty of layers to keep them warm.

Please ensure that your child wears long trousers for Forest School as children need their legs covered.



In Year 3, children are expected to bring their homework/personalised learning book and their reading book in with them EVERY day. Please ensure that your child has the correct equipment each day. At home, please remember to hear your child read. A little each day is better than a longer slot only once a week. Children can access Accelerated Reader to complete quizzes on the books they have read and TTRockstars to practise their times tables. Year 4 have settled into class extremely well and have matured so much since they were in Year 2. I have been really impressed by their grown up attitude to learning and their constant resilience when tackling new and tricky problems.

We have hit the ground running as we returned to school this week and have started our new English unit based on the story 'Bike Boy' by Jane Considine.

Within Maths, we will be focussing on addition and subtraction of 4-digit numbers and making sure we can solve various types of questions.



In Science, we will be looking at 'sound' and discovering how sound is made using vibrations, how the pitch can be changed and how sounds become quieter over a distance. We have linked our Computing to match this by focussing on audio editing and have already started recording our voices onto the school computers.

The Romans

In History, we are learning all about the Romans and trying to figure out why Rome wasn't built in a day. This links in well with our Art work, which is all about Roman mosaics. If your child decides to make their own mosaic at home, please send this in (or upload a photo onto Seesaw) and we can add it to our Romans display!

We have no Forest School this half term, but expect to resume again in January.

What an exciting half term this is with the lead up to Christmas yet we are confident that the children in Year 5 will continue to impress us with the effort and focus they are putting into their work. We are fortunate to have a PGCE student- Mr Horner- joining us this half term and he will be working with the children at different points under the guidance of Mrs Clarke who is our Student Mentor and myself- Mrs Clark.

This half term, our learning is around the theme of Changes.

In Geography, we will be looking at changes in our local environment and this will include a local walk which I am sure the children will enjoy: more information will follow.

In Science, the children will build on their learning from last half term and learn about reversible and irreversible changes. This will link to their work in Design and Technology which will involve food and cooking.

In Music, the children will build on their previous learning playing the glockenspiels and learning a range of musical elements whilst reflecting on how Music connects us to our environment. Their learning in RE, will be around Islam and the Qur'an.

As the term progressed, they began to take up important roles and responsibilities as well as proving themselves to be really kind and patient buddies to our new reception children.
